

## Chico Outsiders Bag Tag Rules - 2012

The bag tag competition is a fundraiser for Peregrine Point disc golf course, thank you for your support!

**Bag Tag Competition:** Many disc golf courses have an annual bag tag competition. The main point of the competition is to meet new players, inspire a spirit of competition, and try to end the year with the lowest numbered tag.

Bag Tags will be on sale by mid-February and may be purchased online at [www.chico-outsiders.com](http://www.chico-outsiders.com), at local retailers Sports LTD or North Rim Adventure Sports, or from the monthly sales booth at Peregrine Point. Pick up your tag and play in this year's competition at the Peregrine Point disc golf course.

### Bag Tag Rules -

#### Conduct

1. Everyone is on their honor to conduct themselves according to the rules and within the spirit of competition. Have fun. It's only a tag.
2. Each player must have their Bag Tag when playing Peregrine Point. Bag Tags should be plainly visible and cannot be hidden.

#### Challenging Other Players

1. Only challenges at Peregrine Point must be accepted.
2. The higher Bag Tag challenges the lower Bag Tag. Challenges can be by phone, email or in person.
3. The challenged player must give the challenger two times to meet in the next two weeks or they must forfeit the tag. If challenger cannot meet that timeline, the challenge is void. Not showing up for a match results in a forfeit (20 minute leeway).

#### Basic Rules

1. PDGA and course rules (OBs) apply.
2. If the challenger wins the round, the tags are exchanged.
3. Ties are won by the holder of the lower bag tag at the beginning of the round. However, if ALL players agree before the round starts; a play-off hole(s) can be used as a tie-breaker using sudden death rules.
4. A group of players taking part in a challenge will exchange tags so the best score holds the lowest tag, and the worst score the highest. Ties go to the player holding the lower tag at the start of the round.
5. You don't have to play back-to-back challenge rounds.
6. If a player does not complete a bag tag challenge round, the exiting player should trade tags with the player with the highest tag number. If play is stopped by all players before the round is complete, no tags are exchanged.
7. Outsiders Events: It is mandatory to accept challenges at any Chico Outsiders organized tournament, monthly, or weekly game.
8. Each tournament may specify different Bag Tag rules. For example, players may compete in flights (different skill levels), the entire field (all players), or only within their immediate group. If not specified the Bag Tag competition is assumed to only include players in your immediate group.

#### Miscellaneous

1. Tags are on sale during the month of February, until the final Bag Tag tournament of the year (October or November). Bag Tag membership benefits last until March 1<sup>st</sup> of the following year.
2. Members can purchase a replacement for a lost tag for \$10.00 and will receive the lowest numbered tag available. If no tags remain, a lost tag excludes you from the ongoing competition. Non-members who lose a tag must purchase a new tag.
3. The President of the Chico Outsiders may modify the rules if necessary to improve play, eliminate controversy, or streamline the competition.
